Happy New Year all, I am looking forward to big muskies in the boat this year and the stories of the ones that got away. We finished up the business of 2013 at our planning meeting in December. You will find the schedule of events in the newsletter. Items of note in next year's events calendar:

1) The Border War Tournament with the Shawnee club is March 22<sup>nd</sup>, it is at Lake Kincaid this year. We need lots of participation from our club, it's embarrassing that we have not won the bragging rights for several years, this is a great time and the

Shawnee club does a great job of hosting this event. Lake Kincaid is a great fishery and it is not unusual to catch multiple 45 inch plus fish in a day. There is a Pomme Club "Strategic Planning Session" Friday night March 21st. Club headquarters are at The Americas Best Value Inn in Murphysboro Illinois. - 2) The Gil Hamm Muskie Inc Tournament is back at Lake of the Woods for 2014. The dates are August 20-22. We need more people to go to this great event. We will be staying at the Red Wing Lodge again this year. Red Wing Lodge is providing a fantastic raffle for us to utilize this year in our fund raising efforts. - 3) The Fall Tournament is the club's  $\underline{40^{th}}$  anniversary; the paybacks this year are 45% of the entry fees. This is double the payback of the several previous year's tournaments. The tournament is the  $1^{st}$  weekend in October.
- 4) The CPR Tournament is 1 day only on Saturday October 18<sup>th</sup>. The payback this year is 80% of the entry fees.

Remember, the proceeds from these tournaments are used to support the projects of our chapter. All the proceeds stay within the chapter. This year we are providing 2 rolls of Avery netting to the MDC's Lost Valley Hatchery in Warsaw Mo. at a cost of \$2,124. These nets substantially increase the yield of the muskie fingerlings by covering the rearing pools at the hatchery. We have also pledged to provide \$2,500 worth of ADA compliant picnic table for the Busch Wildlife Pavilion in St Louis Mo. contingent on a matching donation from the Hugh Becker Foundation. Our 1<sup>st</sup> sports show event this year will be in Kansas City January 23<sup>rd</sup> thru the 26<sup>th</sup>. We are updating the booth this year. A few years back the Pomme De Terre Chamber of Commerce gave the club their old pop-up display. We are utilizing it as a new backdrop for our booth. We will have up to date pictures and club information on it. This was a badly needed improvement that was needed to keep our booth current with the times. Drop by for a visit; don't feel intimidated if you can't work the booth. We understand that not everybody can commit that amount of time.



The Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) invites conservation-minded muskie anglers to help us evaluate Missouri's muskellunge management program. We need a wide cross-section of muskie anglers at all levels of skill and experience. Missouri's Muskellunge Plan sets muskie angler catch-rate objectives, which can be documented most efficiently by anglers themselves. If you choose to participate, here's how the program will work.

#### Mail in your forms once a year or when you are done Missouri Muskie Fishing

Every year, we will send you a postage-paid envelope so you can mail in your Trip Record forms to MDC's Muskellunge Program Coordinator. We will also send you a supply of blank forms, which you can complete and keep in your file during the next recording period. All individual information sent to the Muskellunge Program Coordinator will be considered confidential. However, you will receive group results in an annual newsletter, along with other information updating you on Missouri's progress in culturing and managing muskies.

All member ID cards are to be printed by members once accessing their account User Profile.

There will be a link on the user profile page (upper right hand corner) that will allow them to print and retain their own ID Cards at ANY TIME. For family members the family head will be able to print the entire families ID's.

#### **CPR Tournament Revisions**

In an effort to increase participation in the Fall CPR Tournament we are making some changes to the format of the event:

The event will be one day only, Saturday October, 18<sup>th</sup>. It is hoped that this will allow more people to participate.

The payout has been increased to 80% of the entry fees. This is very high in the tournament world and is possible because we will not be mailing information about the tournament except in the fall tournament mailing. All confirmations of the entry will be emailed so be sure there is a good, legible email address on the entry form.

We have left the entry fee at \$80 per boat to increase the payout. With only 15 boats participating we will pay out \$500 to the winning team, \$300 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and \$150 for 3<sup>rd</sup>. The big fish pot (optional) of \$10 per team is 100% payout for the big fish. The prize money will be adjusted for the actual number of participants so the potential prize money could be more than the above example.
