Club Release Patch Policy

Following is a re-statement of our clubs policy concerning Release Patches. Administration of the Release Patches is done by the Release Chairman. Members who wish to receive a patch for a 30" release must mark the box on the Lunge Log reporting form. The form is on our web site.

The qualification for a Fifty Inch Release Patch and Century Club Release Patches are to be celebrated accomplishments and awarded at the next available club meeting by the president.

Patch Information

THE RELEASE PATCH



Members who release any muskie 30 inches or longer and indicate they want a patch by notation on the Lunge Log Entry Form will be issued the Muskies Inc. Release Patch. There is no charge for the patch. Only one patch for each release will be issued at no charge. Additional patches are \$1.00 each. The embroidered patch is 3.75" x 1.5". Administration of the patch is done by the Release Chairman.

THE FIFTY INCH RELEASE PATCH



This patch illustrates two 50-inch fish released

A patch given to members who have caught and released a muskie 50-inches and longer. It has a blank at the bottom with to apply 4 white stars. A patch with no stars represents one 50-inch fish, you will be issued a second master patch and subsequent stars to represent each 50-inch release. This process continues for each multiple of five releases. Only one patch or star for each release will be issued at no charge. Additional patches are \$3.00 each, stars are \$1.00 ea. The embroidered patch is 3.5" x 4". Administration of the patch is done by the Release Chairman.

THE CENTURY CLUB PATCH



This patch illustrates 400 Lunge Log entries

A patch given to members who have reported 100 or more entries to the Lunge Log in their lifetime. In the event a member reaches the second 100 entries they will be issued a purple blank with a white star to represent an additional 100 entries. Members will receive a white star for each subsequent 100 entries. Additional purple blanks and stars are issued as the purple blanks are filled. Each purple blank holds 4 stars. Only one patch, star and purple blank for each 100 releases will be issued at no charge. Additional Century Patches are \$4.00 each, stars and purple blanks are \$1.00 ea. The embroidered patch is 4.25" x 3.625". Administration of the patch is done by the Release Chairman.

REVISED DATE REVISED DINNER LOCATION CHAPTER CHALLENGE/BORDER WARS

The annual Chapter Challenge/Border Wars event between the Pomme de Terre Chapter of Muskies Inc and the Shawnee Muskie Hunters will be held on Lake Pomme De Terre in southwest Missouri in 2013. This is a great opportunity to be on the lake in early spring, fish for pre-spawn muskies and get out of the house for the weekend.

What: Border Wars

When: Saturday, March 23rd, 2013. Fishing hours are from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Starting and Check-in Point: State Park Marina. Marina is located off highway 64B about 2.1 miles from the intersection of highways 64 and 64B. Launch ramp. Marina will not be open for meals or coffee.

Saturday Night Dinner: Dinner on Saturday night will be about 5:30pm at the Pittsburg Community Center. This is located in Pittsburg, and is across the road from the ALPS grocery store. It sets back off the road about 200 yards. Plenty of parking if you are pulling your boat. Menu will probably be steak, baked potato, salad, and desert. Show up any time after about 5:00 and bring your own beverages.

Prizes: The winning chapter will receive a traveling plaque with their name on it and bragging rights for a year. The boat with the highest point total will win a jacket for each fisherman.

Entry fee: \$40 per boat. Any profits from the event will be split between the chapters. Mail entry form and check to the address shown on the form to be received one week before the event. After that, please call the contact person to let them know you are coming so the proper number of steaks can be purchased.

Breakfast: Outfitters Grill, located on highway 64, .2 miles north of the intersection of 64 and 64B. 1.4 miles from Indian Hills. .6 miles from Nemo Resort. Also open for lunch and dinner.

Rules

- 1) Maximum of 2 fishermen per boat. At least one must be a member of one of the chapters.
- 2) All Missouri Conservation Water Safety Regulations will be in force. Live bait prohibited. Trolling has a one rod with one lure limit per person. If there is only one person in a boat they may troll two rods. The Alabama, umbrella and similar rigs may be fished so long as they use only one lure with hooks. The remaining attachment points can include similar lures so long as their hooks have been removed or other hook-less attractors such as spinner blades are used.
- 3) All 30" and longer Muskies count for points and must be released immediately when caught Muskies must be measured with the ruler laying on a flat surface. Time of release must be entered on Release Form when witnessed. A digital photo of the length must be presented to the tournament official with the release slip for the fish and must be filled out and signed by same person.
- 4) Muskies will be scored .as follows: 4 Points for each 30" Muskie plus 1/4 point for each additional 1/4 inch, measure to the nearest 1/4 inch. The total points for a chapter will be divided by the number of teams participating and the team with the highest average will be the winner.
- 5) In case of a tie for big fish, winners will be determined by earliest release time on Release Form. No kept Muskie will be allowed for tournament entry.
- 6) No alcoholic beverages will be allowed during tournament hours.
- 7) The Tournament Committee is the final judge of all tournament rules and decisions. Life jackets must be worn at any time that a boat is underway, except that the jacket need not be worn while trolling.

Northeast Missouri Muskie Outing

June 8th & 9th, 2013

If you want a unique muskie fishing opportunity come join the *Northeast MO Muskie Outing* sponsored by Pomme Chapter of Muskie, Inc. June 8th & 9th 2013. The outing will start at Henry Sever Lake at Newark, MO on June 8th. (Henry Sever is located 1 mile north of Newark, MO on Rt. KK) Launch time will be at 7:00 A.M. Henry Sever is a 158 acre lake. Outboard motors in excess of 10 horsepower must operate at slow, no wake speed. Muskie fishing success at Henry Sever has been improving the last couple of years. Lunch will be provided by Pomme Chapter members for all participating in the outing. (Hot dogs, brats, chips and drinks).

The Northeast Muskie Outing will continue on June 9th at Hazel Creek Lake, about three miles north of Kirksville, MO, then 1.5 miles west on Buck Creek Road. (When Buck Creek swings to the right, continue straight to the lake.) The boat ramp on the north side will be used for the outing. Hazel Creek Lake is 530 acres and is owned and operated by the city of Kirksville, MO. Only electric motors are permitted. Hazel Creek Lake is noted for having many muskie over 40".

Event Descriptions

Border War Tournament – Members of Missouri Muskies compete against the Shawnee Musky Hunters of Illinois. The competition is held at home lakes of Pomme de Terre and Kincaid lakes on a rotating basis. 2013 war will be held at Pomme de Terre Lake.

Musky Mayhem – Members meet and fish at Pomme de Terre Lake. New members will be “guided” by an existing member to get them introduced to the lake, hot spots, lures, techniques, etc.

Northern Musky Trail – Members will meet at Henry Sever Lake to fish Saturday and then move to Hazel Creek Lake to fish Sunday. The lakes are within a few hours of each other and it is a chance for us to use those stocked lakes as well as Pomme.

Kids' Day - Fishing event provides a day to bring kids and family to the state park marina to fish for crappie (and whatever else bites). Fish are measured and weighed and records are kept. This is for kids from 5 to 16.

Pomme de tours (Pomme and Lindley arms of the lake) are held for members to educate them on fishing spots, lures, techniques to catch Muskies. Using a pontoon boat, the tours are led by our professional guides. This is a great opportunity to socialize with other members and to learn where and how to fish the lake. This is free for members but expenses for the boat and gas are shared. Bring your lunch or buy lunch while at a stop on the tour.

Guide for a Day (GFAD) – This is a significant fundraiser for our club. Existing members guide potential members (from sports shows or other ads). The goal is to provide a good example of what fishing for muskies is all about and have a great steak dinner. This has led to many new members in the past.

Fall Tournament – This is the best fishing time of the year and this is our clubs' premier event. Cash prizes are awarded. There are two tournaments in the same weekend – Friday tournament and Saturday/Sunday tournament. A big meal and program are held Saturday night. Drawings for prizes are held as well.

CPR (Catch, Photograph, Release) tournament – This tournament is held at the end of October to encourage fishing at ANY Missouri Lake or Kincaid Lake in southern Illinois. Cash prizes are awarded for the largest fish.

Pick Three Outing – Each member picks three lures to fish with. They can only use those lures for the day. Big Fish pot is voluntary. Braggin' rights apply for the first, most, largest etc.
