ON LINE MUSKIES INC. MEMBER ID CARD PRINTING

Starting January 2014 a new member ID card process will be implemented, but it will be ready for use by existing members who are renewing their membership by December 1st.

All member ID's will be printed by members once accessing their account User Profile. There will be a link on the user profile page (upper right hand corner) that will allow them to print and retain their own ID Cards at ANY TIME. For family members the family head will be able to print the entire families ID's.

We will be eliminating MI supplying ID cards effective 1/1/2014. This will save the organization dollars in monthly expenditures for the imprinting and managing of the ID cards. Pick 3 Outing Rules

The pick 3 outing is a low key outing that fosters camaraderie among participants. Participation is open to club members and non-members.

- 1) Entry fee is 1 respectable muskie lure (new or used) donation per participant.
 - A) Winner of outing gets 1st choice of donated lures.
 - B) Remaining lures are awarded by random drawing.
- 2) All 30" and longer muskies are scored and must be released immediately when caught.
- 3) Muskies will be scored as follows: 4 Points for each 30" Muskie plus 1/4 point for each additional 1/4 inch, measure to the nearest 1/4 inch.
- 4) In case of a tie, winner will be determined by flip of a coin.
- 5) This is an individual competition so there is no limit on number of participants per boat.
- 6) Trolling has a one rod with one lure limit per person.
- 7) The Honor System is used as proof of fish caught. Digital photographs or partner witness is encouraged.
- 8) We will meet at the State Park Marina at 8AM Saturday November 9th to declare what <u>3</u> <u>actual lures</u> you are going to use.
 - A) Lures have to be specific, not generic such as "spinnerbait".
 - B) You cannot pick a lure and use other colors of the same lure, only the 3 declared.
 - C) If you lose one, fish with only two.
 - D) No need to remove other lures from your boat, honor system is in place.
- 9) Fishing will be limited to 4 ½ hours, all participants must return to the State Park Marina by 12:30PM for award.
- 10) Life jackets must be worn at any time that a boat is underway, except that the jacket need not be worn while trolling.




Skyler Schlick 40 %" Muskie Sunday's Big Fish Winner, Pomme De Terre Lake Team Muskie Tournament

The weather for Friday was partly cloudy air temperature in the mid 80's, Saturday had falling air temperature and rain at start time continuing throughout the day with hard rain starting around 11 am lasting until around 1:30. Sky cleared by end of fishing. Temperature during periods of rain was 55 degrees, warming to 65 degrees by end of day. Sunday had morning air temperature of 45 degrees, clear skies and air temperature of 58 degrees by noon. Water temperature was in the mid seventies throughout the 3 days of fishing.

Over the 3 days a total of 31 fish were boated and released successfully, 2 fish were over 40 inches with most fish in the mid 30's. There are a large class of fish approaching the 40 inch thresh hold which will make for big numbers of large fish starting next year.
