Pomme de Terre Lake has been stocked with muskies since the mid 60's and has catch rates higher than lakes "up north". We average an encounter every 6.2 hours and a catch every 13.8 hours. Spring & fall are the best time for muskie fishing as water temperatures are either heating up or cooling down triggering the muskie to actively feed providing even better fishing than the averages. Multiple muskie days are not uncommon with sizes up to 48 inches in length.

If you don't know how to fish for muskies, this is the opportunity to learn. We will pair you up with an

experienced Muskie fisherman for a full day on the water at the peak times of the year to catch a Muskie. It's okay you don't have tackle, we provide rods, lures and all the other items needed for the day. This is a great opportunity to experience Muskie fishing in Missouri.
